#### 1. Housing for Pastors/Delegates

Housing is supplemented \$26 per pastor/ delegate, per night. (Pastors & delegates traveling over 100 miles, or member of a committee meeting on Thursday, will receive the housing supplement for Thursday night.)

- A. **Dormitory Housing at Sky Lodge** Bunk beds—bring bedding, pillow, towels, and toiletries. \$26 per person, per night. (Conference covers this fee.)
- B. Couples/Family Housing at Sky Lodge Motel rooms or cabins—bring bedding, pillow, towels and toiletries for cabin, towels and toiletries for motel rooms. \$60-\$81 per night, per unit. (Conference covers \$26 of the above cost, per night, you will be charged the balance.)
