

## A NOTE FROM THE DEAN:


If you look at the account of creation in Genesis one, you'll pick up on a pattern: God creates, and then he's pleased with his work. He sees that it is good.

We're made in that likeness, and are called to be pleased with the work of our hands, hearts, and minds. However, in order to be pleased with the outcome, we first have to do the hard work of work!

In Colossians 3, we're told this:

“Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters, since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.” (v. 23-24)

This means that even when we're washing dishes, doing garbage runs, guarding lives we're serving Christ through our ministry here at camp. Keep this in mind as you work in your service areas this week: We're not just serving campers, but Christ himself.
